PRIZES

First Prize - \$400

Second Prize - \$250

Third Prize - \$150

The judges reserve the right to award only those prizes that meet the standards expected in the competition. The winner may be invited to perform with wcf symphony at the discretion of Artistic Director, Jason Weinberger.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be Iowa residents and be enrolled in grades eight through twelve. Qualified entrants will be advised of their audition times by early February, 2020.

REPERTOIRE

Applicants must be prepared to perform, on the day of competition, from memory, one fast movement of a standard solo concerto for which there is an orchestra accompaniment. Applicants are required to provide their own accompanist and music. Upon request, names of local accompanists will be provided. One published copy of the piano score must be provided for the judges: NO PHOTOCOPIES PLEASE. Each entrant will be allowed eight minutes to play for judges. Appropriate cuts should be clearly marked in the piano score.

APPLICATION

The entry fee for the 2020 wcf symphony Young Artist Concerto Competition is \$30.00. *Application form and entry fee must be postmarked no later than January 16, 2020.*
