- Each applicant will be allowed eight minutes to play for the judges.
- Applicants are required to provide their own accompanist and music. Upon request, names of local accompanists will be provided by the YACC chairperson listed below.
- One published copy of the piano score with appropriate cuts clearly marked, must be provided for the judges. NO PHOTOCOPIES PLEASE.

The judges reserve the right to award only those prizes that meet the standards expected in the competition. The winner may be invited to perform with the *wcfsymphony* during the 2024-25 season at the discretion of Artistic Director Jason Weinberger.
